# Administrative Hearing Commission

The Administrative Hearing Commission is a central hearing panel, with formal proceedings similar to judge tried cases in Circuit Court. The Commission hears cases concerning virtually every Missouri state agency matter, including: professional licensing, employment disqualification lists, health facility licensure, child and adult daycare facility licensure, Medicaid provider compliance, appeals of medical marijuana license denials, state merit system discipline appeals, state income/sales/use tax appeals (including multistate tax compact issues), state campaign finance laws, civil rights cases, state environmental permits, liquor control licensure, and parent appeals under the Federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

The team at Sandberg Phoenix includes a former Commissioner, who served the longest term in the Commission's history, over 11 years, with over 1,500 decisions, including those published in Westlaw, Lexis, and Fastcase, as well as cases involving the Federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, state merit system appeals, the Missouri Commission on Human Rights, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
